BUBBLE CHURCH BEGAN AT ASCENSION BALHAM IN 2020, DURING A TIME WHEN CHURCHES WERE CLOSED DUE TO COVID AND ONLY ALLOWED TO REOPEN FOR SOCIALLY DISTANCED "BUBBLES." WITHIN JUST A FEW MONTHS, BUBBLE CHURCH AT ASCENSION WAS WELCOMING OVER 100 PEOPLE EACH WEEK. WITH SUPPORT FROM THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND, IT HAS NOW LAUNCHED IN MORE THAN 80 CHURCHES ACROSS THE COUNTRY.

BUBBLE CHURCH IS A SERVICE JOYFULLY DESIGNED FOR PARENTS OF LITTLE ONES AND THEIR FAMILIES. FAMILIES SIT TOGETHER ON A "BUBBLE MAT" (A SMALL CIRCULAR CARPET) AND TAKE PART IN A SHORT, INTERACTIVE WORSHIP EXPERIENCE. EACH SERVICE INCLUDES:

- ACTION SONGS
- A BIBLE STORY (WITH PUPPETS!)
- A CREATIVE RESPONSE
- A "GOD SPOT" WHERE CHILDREN OFFER PRAYERS OF THANKS AND PRAISE
- BEAUTIFUL LITURGY, ALL WRAPPED INTO A 25-30-MINUTE SERVICE

Stay and Paly Update



At a recent St. George's PCC (Parochial Church Council) meeting Heather proposed starting a stay and play morning for pre-school children. This was approved but the discussion turned to practical matters and one of these was storage particularly of larger pieces of play equipment. A shed was agreed upon, and a donation was offered. From this an area was selected but it had a huge buddleia bush, a large mound of compost, wood, bricks and various other items on it.

So, a working party was organised and the buddleia cut down and chopped up before being dispatched to the tip. Then the stump was taken out.

All the wonderful, old bricks were looked at and it was decided they could be reused as a solid foundation for the shed.

We also wanted to be part of the solid foundation so we wrote our names on the bricks. They won't be seen again after the shed is erected but just as our faith is our solid foundation we know they're there and they will give this shed (and the stay and play group) a strong, faithful base.

The compost was cleared and all the other stuff removed after a second working party.

We are now at the point of finishing laying the base and a path. The shed has been ordered and will be erected on the 2nd January, 2026. It will be called 'Geoff's shed' and we are grateful for the donation to enable this to happen. We are also grateful for all the hard work that has gone into this project for the love, energy and care that has helped bring it to life.

Chocolate Slabs

This activity offers you and your familiy a chance, in the darker days of the year, to pause together, share conversation, and bring the light and love of Jesus into the heart of your home.



INGREDIENTS

A bar of chocolate, or two
(vegan, milk, or dark will
all work)
Pretzels
Sprinkles
Chocolate chips
Marshmallows/sweets

DIRECTIONS

- Melt your chocolate-microwave or bowl over boiling water.
- Pour onto a lined tray and spread to
 2–5mm thickness.
- 3. Sprinkle your chosen toppings and chill in the fridge to set.
- 4. While it sets, gather your family around the toppings.

Use each ingredient to spark reflection:

- Pretzels: What's salty in your life?
 What annoys or upsets you
- Sprinkles: Where can you sprinkle love and light?
- Chocolate chips: They're strong— Psalm 27:1 says, "The Lord is the stronghold of my life." What does that mean to you
- Marshmallows/sweets: They bring comfort. The verse reminds us not to be afraid. What comforts you?


